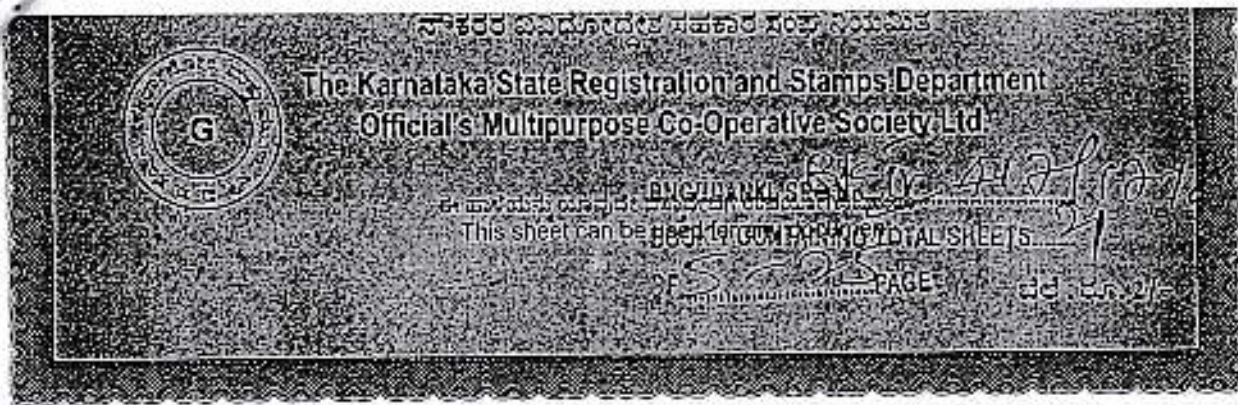

1. **Name of the Trust:**

The Trust shall be called **SHREE VIDHYA VARDHI EDUCATIONAL & CHARITABLE TRUST.**

2. **Registered office of the Trust:**

The Registered office of the trust shall be at Buksagara (V), Jigani Hobli, Anekal Taluk, Bangalore (U) District- 560105, and such other place or places as may be determined by the trustees from time to time.

3. **Commencement of the Trust;**

The Trust shall come into force on the date of registration of this trust deed.

4. **Area of Operation:**

The Trust shall have the area of operation throughout the State of Karnataka and all over India and Abroad as may be determined by the Trustees.

5. **Objects of the Trust**

The Objects of the Trust are.

- a)
 - i) To afford relief and to render services to the poor, Telugu linguistic minority society and every aims and objective gives importance to develop Telugu linguistic minority society.
 - ii) To afford relief and to render services to the poor, and to promote Indian culture, Literature and the advancement of educational activities;
- b) To start educational institutions, to acquire, to take over and assume management of any such educational institutions and run any of the existing educational institutions.
- c) To build and run hostels, libraries for the benefit of the Telugu linguistic minority students and professionalisms.
- d) To start and run Hospitals, Medical centers and assist the institutions having objects similar to that of this trust;

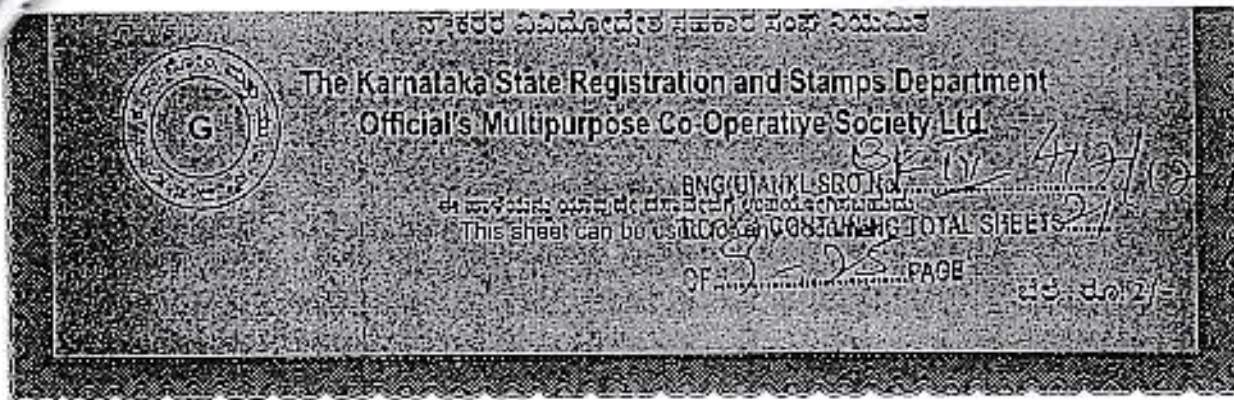

- e) to help and assist in spreading education by extending assistance to Schools, Colleges, institutions, Research centers, academic and Vedic associations;
- f) to build, run and maintain auditorium, community hall, Kalyana Mantapa and place of worship for the use of the community at large;
- g) to acquire and/or purchase sites and buildings for constructing buildings in furtherance of the objects of this trust;
- h) To uplift the down trodden and socially and economically backward class, to assist people belonging to SC/ST and to eradicate superstition and social evils;
- i) to acquire or purchase, start and run printing press, book depot and to organize such other ancillary wings;
- j) to make such other objects for general public utility not inconsistent with the spirit and object of this trust; but shall not include any activity for profit or gain within the meaning of Income Tax Act, 1961.
- k) Rendering and affording of medical relief and aid in India and for the purpose aforesaid to open, establish, maintain, manage, control and conduct free dispensaries, hospitals, nursing homes, maternity homes, Sanatoriums, Health Care Centre, Nature Cure Hospital and medical and first aid centers, ambulances.
- l) To carry out and assist in 'carrying out activities which are philanthropic and charitable in nature for helping the poor and relieve their misery and poverty conditions by starting and maintaining Old Age Home
- m) To establish and conduct training centre for computer education in all disciplines of education including engineering and medical colleges, and all other fields of education and for job oriented courses.

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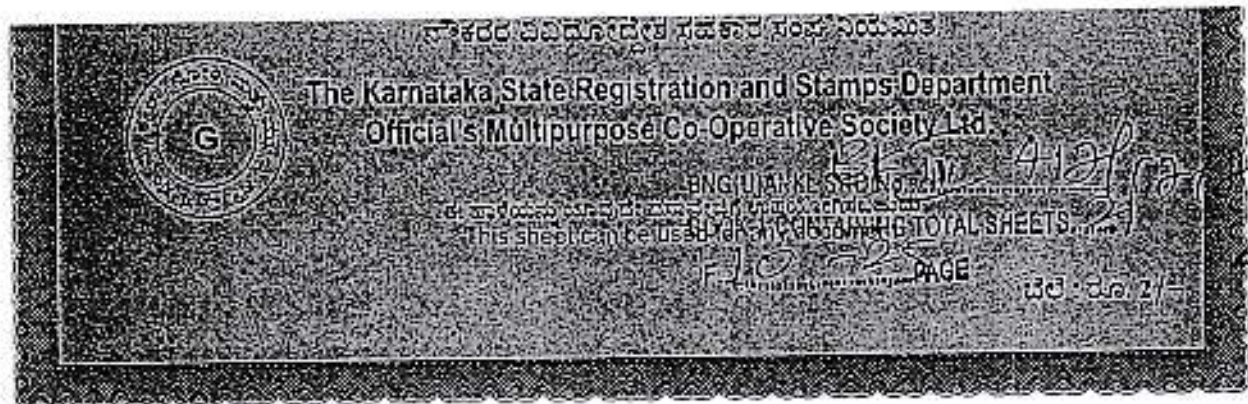

- n) To establish and maintain residential Schools and colleges with boarding facilities, running hostels for students.
- o) To establish Agricultural farms and research centre for development of Agriculture.
- p) To help poor people in performing marriages.
- q) To arrange for free distribution of meals, clothes and other necessary things to poor and needy people on important occasions and festival days.
- r) To develop sports and athletic potential of children.
- s) To develop artistic, musical and other talents of children.
- t) To develop sufficient and proper Infrastructure (including Computer Assisted Learning & Technology- related educational inputs) to ensure 100% enrollment and full retention of children in schools.
- u) To undertake any educative activity or project for adults in a community with a special emphasis on young mothers in order to generate and to sustain a child friendly environment.
- v) To work for the elimination of the practice of child labour.
- w) To contribute to any public cause.
- x) To donate or contribute to any fund established by the Central or State Government for the Welfare and benefit of the General Public including any specific relief fund.
- y) To undertake Rural Development programmes.
- z) To promote/provide for the welfare of orphans, Destitute, widows and other deserving helpless persons or to contribute to any institutions engaged in such activities.
- aa) To promote unity and brotherhood amongst the members of the public and Communal Harmony.

- bb) To contribute to institutions or Trusts or bodies established for anyone or more of the objects as mentioned hereinabove.
- cc) To raise financial resources for the Trust activities by receiving donations, organizing charity shows, to render professional services for consideration or to collect fees through other educational/medical activities of the Trust.
- dd) To do such other acts in additions to and in furtherance of the above objects.
- ee) To construct places for worship and to assist financially for the construction, administration and management of places of worship.
- ff) To construct and let-out on annual, monthly, weekly or daily rentals, the commercial buildings, complexes, residential houses, residential apartments and industrial sheds.
- gg) To establish departmental stores, shopping malls and super market.
- hh) To do all such other acts as may be deemed necessary, proper and expedient to fulfill the aims and objects of the Trust.
- ii) To establish and run educational and vocational schools or institutions both academic and carrier.
- jj) To establish and run colleges, academic and professional.
- kk) To render financial assistance to brilliant students who are financially weak.
- ll) To run institutions for the mentally retarded, the blind and the deaf and the dumb and rehabilitate them;
- mm) To run old age homes and poor homes;
- nn) To accept donations, grants, presents and other offerings and to deal with the same for the purpose of the Trust.

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oo) To do any other charitable activity for the welfare of the community at large;

Provided that in carrying out any objects of general public utility as mentioned hereinabove, they shall not involve the carrying on, of any activity for profit.

6. **Founder Trustees and their tenure:**

The authors of the trust are the settlers (founder trustees) who shall hold office of the trustees for their life time.

7. **Board of Trustees:**

The trust shall be governed by the Board of Trustees consisting of not less than 2 Trustees and not more than 7 Trustees. The authors of the trust shall be the life members. The board of trustees may appoint co-opt trustees for a period of 2 (two) years at a time. The board of trustees shall have the option to extend the term of office of Co-Opt trustees not exceeding 2 years.

8. **Office Bearers:**

- a) The tenure of the Board of Trustees, excluding the settlers (Chairman and Secretary), shall be for a period of ten years and provisions for retirement of such Board of Trustees shall be applicable in respect of them only after first two years. The settlers shall be a lifelong Trustee and after the demise of the first settlers (Chairman and Secretary), the Children and wife of the said first settlers shall be trustees. This nomination as Trustee shall be applicable in case of other succeeding settlers also provided the strength of the trust does not exceed seven trustees. In such a situation, the senior most trustees shall retire to give place to the children and wife of the settlers who has expire.

- b) A Trustee who is not a candidate for any post of office bearers shall preside over the meeting of the Board of Trustees while electing the office bearers.
- c) The Chairman shall be the head of the trust and shall be responsible for the due performance of the object and purpose of this trust.
- d) The Chairman shall be entitled to preside over the meetings of the Board of Trustees. In the absence of the Chairman in any such meeting, the secretary shall be presiding over such meeting from amongst themselves.
- e) The Secretary shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Trust and he shall be in charge of the entire management of the Trust.
- f) All the day to day activities of the trust shall be looked after, carried on and conducted by the Secretary for and on behalf of the trust and the Board of trustees.

9. Vacancy:

- a) Any vacancy in the office of the Chairman and Secretary (settlers) arising in the middle of the term of office by reason of death, resignation, disqualification, or for incapacity to discharge the duties, shall be filled up by the Board of Trustees from electing one amongst the founder trustees, and the term of office as such president or Secretary shall be co-extensive with that of their term of office.
- b) For any reason if the office of the Chairman and Secretary becoming vacant simultaneously, such vacancies can be filled up by the Board of Trustees by electing from amongst the founder trustees and ex-officio trustees and the period of such Chairman and Secretary shall be co-extensive with the term of office.

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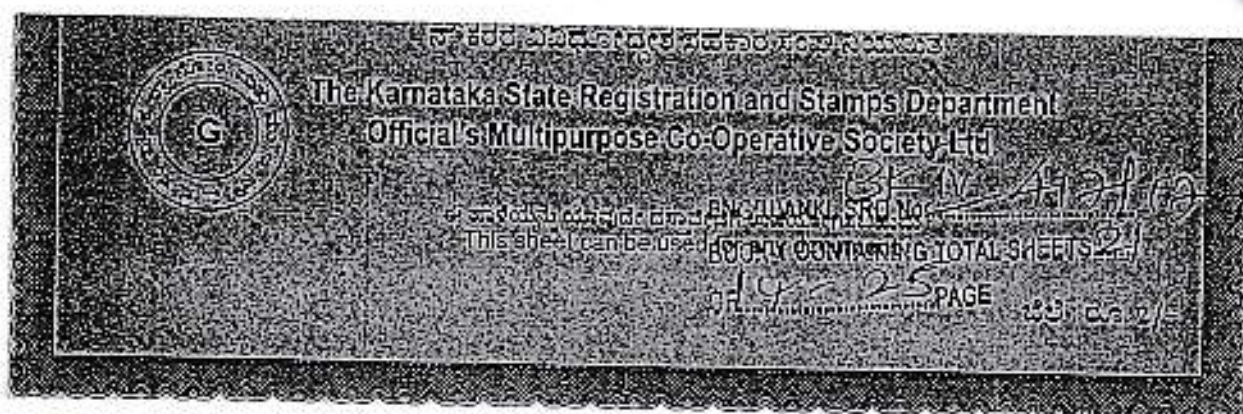

10. Absence from meeting:

Any trustee other than founder trustees remains absent from attending three consecutive meetings of the Board of Trustees without the prior permission of the Chairman in writing shall cease to be the trustee;

Provided that the Board of Trustees may for sufficient reasons to be shown by such absentee trustee, condone the absence of such trustee but so however the Board of Trustees shall not have the power to condone the absence of such trustee remain absent consecutively for more than six months.

11. Quorum:

- a) Quorum for the meeting of Board of Trustees shall be three and the decision shall be taken by a simple majority (Minimum three).
- b) If in any meeting there is no quorum within thirty minutes from the stipulated time, such meeting may be adjourned to any convenient date and on such adjournment meeting no quorum is required;
- c) No fresh notice of the meeting of the adjourned meeting need be issued to the trustees and the decision taken by the majority (Minimum three) in such adjourned meeting shall be legal and binding

12. Decision of the Board of Trustees:

The Secretary shall in consultation with the Chairman place such subjects for consideration of the Board of Trustees. All subjects shall be decided by the Board of Trustees by simple majority. (Minimum three) in case of equality of votes, the Chairman shall have the right of casting vote

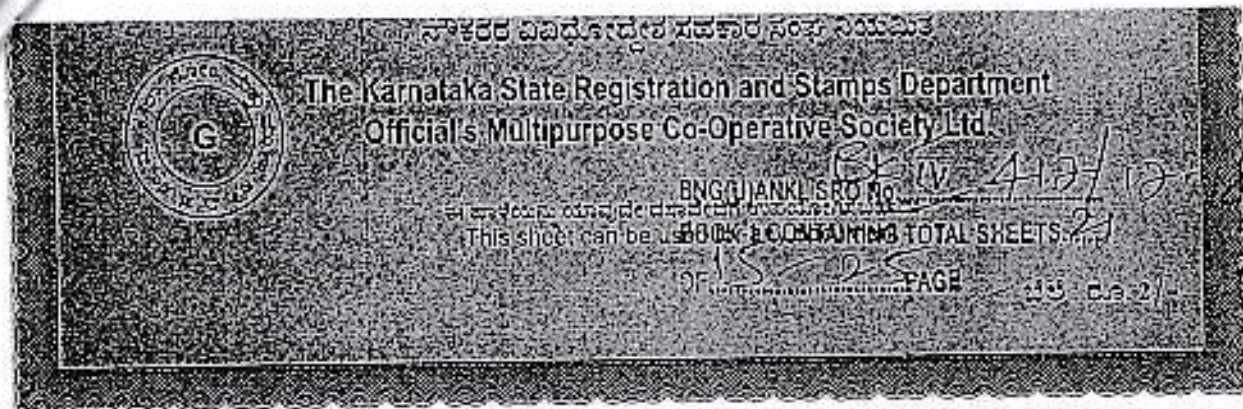

13. **Disqualification:**

- a) If any trustee acts or does anything which is prejudicial to the interest of the trust or opposed to the objects and purpose of this trust, such trustee may be removed by the Board of Trustees in a special meeting convened for the said purpose and by passing a resolution to that effect by majority of the board of Trustees present and voting.

14. **Funds of the Trust:**

The funds of the Trust shall consists of

- The corpus of rupees two thousand five hundred five donated by the authors of this trust and
- Donations or any such kind of article or any materials received from philanthropic purpose.
- Endowments in favour of the trust
- Grants from the central and State Government, corporations and other statutory bodies, corporate bodies and institutions
- Income from the properties of the trust;
- Donations received from general public.
- Any other income, which may accrue in the working of any other institution, controlled and/or managed by the trust

15. **Appointment of committees and framing of Regulations:**

- a) The Board of trustees may appoint advisory committee and Governing bodies for all or any of the institutions managed by the trust and the board of trustee may delegate such of their powers to such committee and bodies on such terms and conditions as they think fit;

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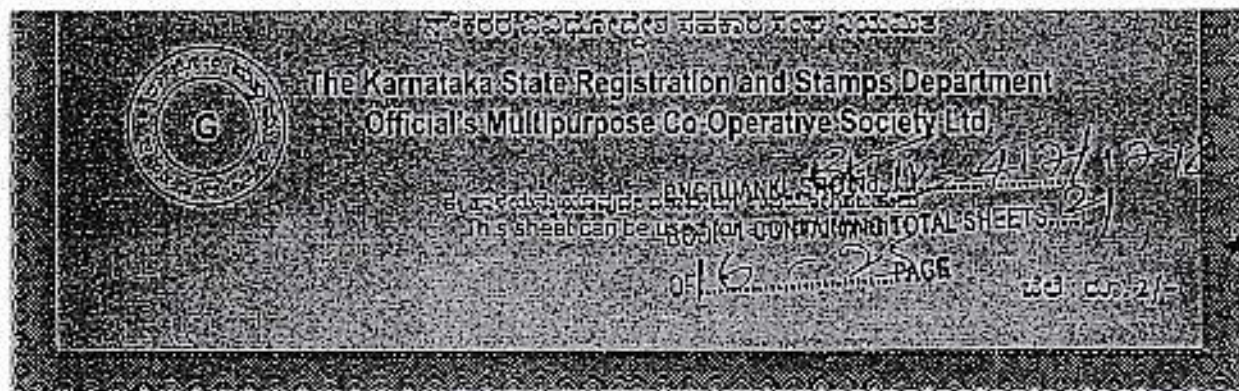

- b) The Board of trustees may frame such rules and regulations for conduct of the affairs of the trust and its institutions and amend or rescind all such rules and regulations from time to time as they deem fit;

16. Powers and duties of the Chairman:

The Chairman of the Trust shall have the following powers:

- he shall preside over all the meetings of the Board of Trustees;
- he shall have the power of casting a vote in case of equality of votes in any meeting of the board of trustees;
- he shall represent this trust in all activities.

17. Powers and duties of the Secretary:

- The secretary shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the trust. He shall be the Chief custodian of all the funds and properties of the trust;
- The Secretary shall call meetings of the board of trustees in consultation with the Chairman and place before the Board of Trustees such subjects which are required to be decided by the Board of Trustees;
- The secretary shall execute all the decisions of the Board of Trustees;
- The Secretary shall have overall supervision over all the employees of the trust and institutions run, controlled and managed by the trust;
- All appointments of employees and other staff of the trust and the institutions shall be made by the Secretary. Such appointments shall be placed before the Board of Trustees for ratification within one month from the date of such appointment. If the Board of

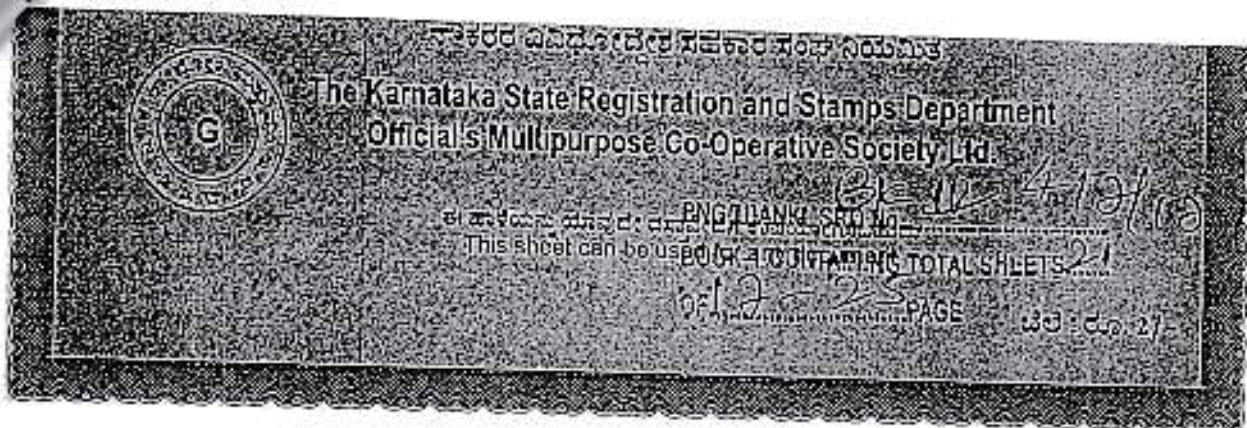

trustees does not ratify or refuse to ratify such appointment, such person who has been initially appointed, shall cease to be the employee under the trusts;

- 6) The Secretary shall have full disciplinary power and institute such proceedings against the employees of the trust and the institution as and when necessary and may impose such punishment as he deems fit in the interest of the trust;
- 7) The Secretary shall operate all the funds of the trust and open accounts in any Nationalized or Scheduled banks in the name of the trust and keep full and correct account of the amount of the trust and institutions run by the trust;
- 8) The Secretary shall have the right to raise such loan as is necessary for the proper management and administration of the trust, its institutions and its properties. However, such raising of loan shall be ratified by the Board of Trustees.
- 9) The secretary shall represent the trust in all matters before courts, Tribunals, authorities and officers. He shall have the right to engage Advocates, Attorneys in all such matters as he may desire. All suits and other proceedings on behalf of the trust shall be instituted in the name of the trust represented by the secretary. Similarly, all suits and proceedings against the trust shall be represented by the Secretary. The Secretary shall have the right to compromise, compound or relinquish the right in all such matters in the best interest of the trust, as he may deem just and necessary.

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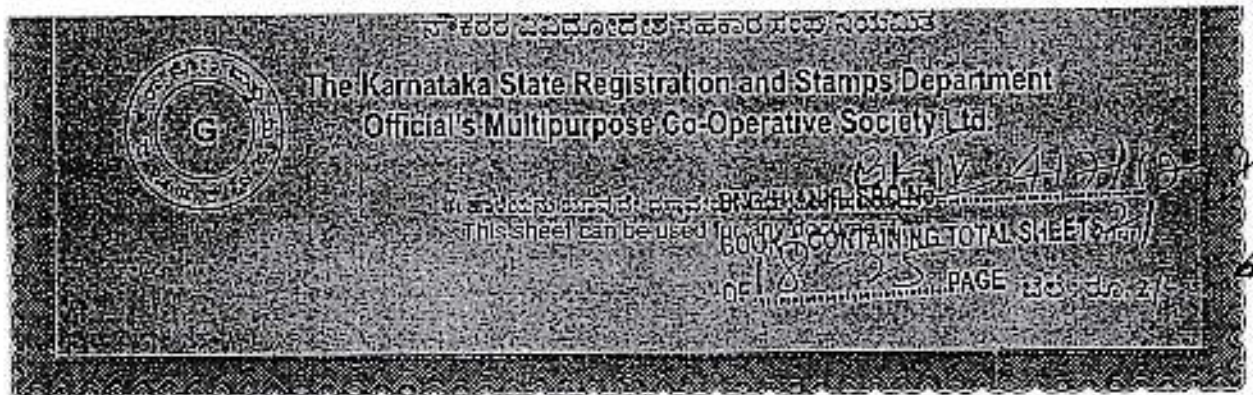

- 10) The Secretary shall have the right to receive such money, property and give valid receipt and discharge for and on behalf of the trust.

18. Powers and duties of the Trustees:

- i) The Board of Trustees shall administer the trust, its institutions, properties and funds and do all such acts, deeds and things as are necessary to promote the objects and purpose for which this trust is created;
- ii) Notwithstanding anything contained herein above no acts, deeds or things shall be invalid because of any vacancy in the Board of Trustees; Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the trustee shall have all the power for the proper implementation of the purpose of this trust including;
 - a) To acquire by purchase, grant, gift, exchange, lease, hire, transfer or otherwise the lands, buildings, stocks, shares, securities, movable and immovable properties of every other description;
 - b) To accept any cash or kind, contribution or gift or donations for anyone and to accept or execute trust, which have the objects and similar to this trust;
 - c) To sell, mortgage, exchange, gift, grant on lease, license, hire and otherwise alginate or transfer all or any of the movable or immovable properties of the trust and in the better interest of the trust;
 - d) To enter into all contracts on behalf of the trust and to rescind the same;
 - e) To borrow money, with or without security and to repay the same by obtaining necessary acknowledgements and discharges;

- f) To accumulate income of the trust in the manner and to the extent permissible under income Tax Act and to invest the funds of the trust not immediately required for the purpose of the trust in such manner as they deem fit and to vary all such investments;
- g) To receive, collect and enforce recovery of all money due or payable to the trust and grant necessary receipts and discharges therefor;
- h) To incur all necessary expenses from the corpus or income of the trust in connection with the better management of the trust and the institutions managed by it.
- iv) a) The Board of trustees shall meet ordinarily not less than once in two months and to meet as often as is necessary;
b) in case of emergency, special emergent meeting shall be called by a notice of two days;
- c) Notice of ordinary meeting shall be given to the Board of Trustees at least 5 days in advance intimating the subjects to be discussed by the trustees;
- v) to appoint sub-committees for any purposes and to empower them with necessary powers and provide funds for specific purpose
- vi) To frame bye-laws and rules, if necessary, for the power implementation of the objects of the trust and effective functioning of the trust, for holding and conduct of general meetings including elections, the management of the institutions run and managed by the trust and the service conditions of the staff.
- vii) To engage the services of Architects, Engineers, Contractors, Carpenters, Fitters and other workman for the purpose of the trust and to pay them such remuneration as may be necessary;
- viii) To engage the services of Chartered Accountant and other experts for the purpose of trust and to pay them such remuneration as may be necessary;

- ix) To specially authorize -all of any of them to represent the trust in all duly constituted courts of law or before any arbitrators, officers or any committee in connection with any measures affecting the interest and welfare of the institution of the trust.
- x) To ensure or keep insured all or any of the buildings or such other properties of the trust and incur and pay the necessary expenses for the same.
- xi) To incur and pay all expenses necessary for carrying all the aims and objectives of this trust;
- xii) To subscribe, to become member of, and co-operative with any other institution or association whether incorporated or not, whose objects are identical or similar to those of this trust and to procure and communicate with any such institution or association such information as may be likely to further the objects of the trust;
- xiii) The Board of trustees shall cause the minutes of all the meetings to be duly recorded in a book specially kept for the purpose as early as possible after the close of the meeting and in no case later than 14 days. If any member of the board of trustees desire to refer to the confirmed minutes of the board, he shall be allowed to do so at the office of the trust during working hours on any working day by giving at least 24 emergent meeting;
- xiv) The Board of Trustees shall have the powers expressly conferred on it by this deed; exercise all such powers and or do all such acts, deeds and things that may,- De exercised or done by the trust at an ordinary or emergent meeting;

- xv) The Board or Trustees shall have the power to frame subsidiary rules, if necessary, governing the service conditions of the employees of the trust and the institutions managed by it.
- xvi) The Board of trustees shall have the power to delegate all of any of the powers and duties on such sub-committees or President or Secretary as may be necessary.
- xvii) The board of Trustees shall have the power to alter or rescind the rules, Bye-laws, subsidiary rules and interpret their meaning whenever, rules, bye-laws and subsidiary rules framed do not cover any emergency or is ambiguous; provided that such charges or interpretations does not conflict with the aims and objects of the trust. If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of the trust deed, the majority of the trustees may, by circulation or otherwise make such provisions not inconsistent with the trust deed as may be necessary or expedient for removing the difficulty;

19. Books of Accounts:

Books of Accounts:
The Secretary shall maintain regular books of account of all receipts and expenditure. The accounting year of the trust shall be from 1st of April to 31st of March of the succeeding year. The accounts of the trust shall be audited annually by a qualified Chartered Accountant.

20. Suits and other Proceedings:

The trust shall be due and be sued through the Secretary. The Secretary is empowered to institute any proceeding in any court, Tribunal or other authorities and may also prefer appeal, revision, review before any higher authorities, to compromise any proceeding, to prosecute and to compound all such offences, to adjust all money in any suit or proceeding and generally act in such manner as he deem fit in the best interest of the trust.

21. **Amendments:**

No amendments shall be made to this deed which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of section 2(15) 11 to 13 and 80(c) of Income Tax Act 1961. The amendment to this trust deed shall be made by a resolution passed at such a special meeting of the trustees convened for the purpose or amending all or any of the provisions of this trust. Such meeting shall be convened by the Secretary by giving at least 15 days clear notice to all the trustees with the proposed amendment and the reasons therefore. The amendment will come into force after the approval of the same of the immediately next meeting of the board of trustees. The trustees shall incorporate the said amendments by executing a deed of amendment in a proper form.

22. **Indemnity:**

The trustees shall be kept fully indemnified and harmless to the trust against any loss suffered and or liability incurred against them for anything done by them in good faith pursuant to the power and authority conferred on them by this deed.

23. **Irrevocability:**

The authors of this trust hereby declare that this trust shall be irrevocable and that all interest and income received by the board of trustees under these presents as well as corpus of any money received by them shall be used and applied for and in furtherance of the objects mentioned above.

24. **Acceptance of Trustees:**

The trustees have hereby declared that they have accepted this trust and hereby undertake to abide by all the terms and conditions imposed by the authors of the trust.

25. **Execution of documents and representing the trust:**
All deeds and other documents to be executed on behalf of the trust or to be executed in favour of the trust shall be done by the Secretary.
26. **Original of this Trust Deed:**
The original of this trust deed shall always be kept in the office of the trust.
27. **Removal of difficulties:**
If at any time any difficulty arises in the interpretation of the terms of the trust or implementing any of the provisions of this trust, the same shall be decided by the board of trustees at a special meeting to be convened for the purpose.
28. **Jurisdiction of the Court:**
All suits or other proceedings pertaining to the administration of this trust, shall be subject to the local jurisdiction of the Bangalore City Civil Court.
29. **DISSOLUTION:**
In the event of dissolution or winding up of the trust, the assets of the trust remaining if any on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the trustees. But the same shall be transferred to any other charitable trust / association / institutions / whose objects are similar to those of this trust, which enjoys re-organisation under Sec. 80(G) of I.T. Act 1961, as amended from time to time.
- a) The provisions of Indian trust act 1882, regarding the disqualification retirement etc., of the trustees will apply to this trust.

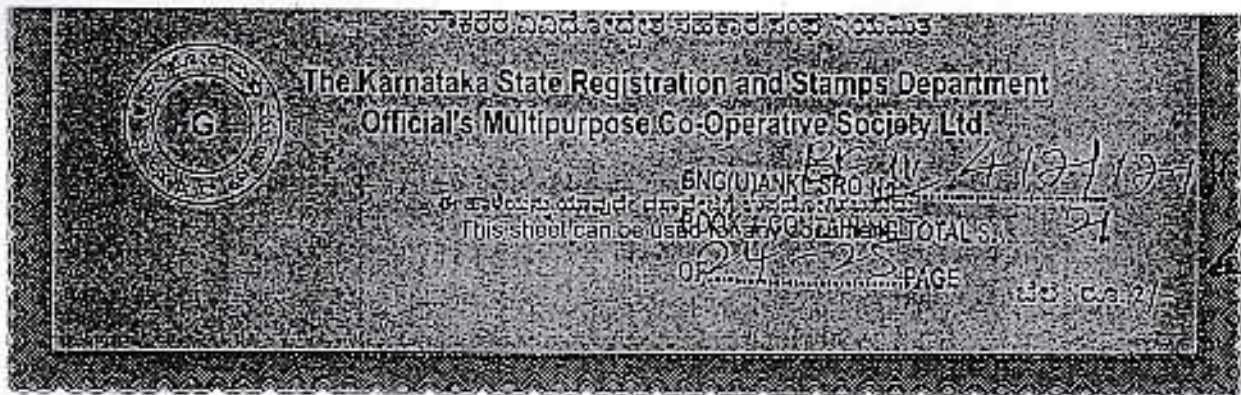

- b) To make donation for any causes under sec. 80 (G) (26) of Indian Income Tax act of 1961 will apply.
- c) The Income derived from the properties shall be applied by the trustees for any one or all of the objects of the trust. Any Income of the trust arising from the corpus which has not been spent in any year shall be invested in accordance with sec. 11(2) of the Indian Income tax Act 1961.
- d) The corpus of the trust shall be invested in the manner laid down in sec. 13(1) of Indian Income tax Act 1961 read with sec. 11(5) of I.T Act. As amended from time to time.
- e) No amendments to the trust Memorandum of Rules and Regulations shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the Provisions of Sections 2(5) 11, 12d 12a and 80 (G) of the Act 1961 as amended from time to time. Further no amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of commissioner of Income Tax.
- f) The benefits of the trust shall be open to all irrespective of cast creed or religion.
- g) The trust hereby created shall be irrevocable.

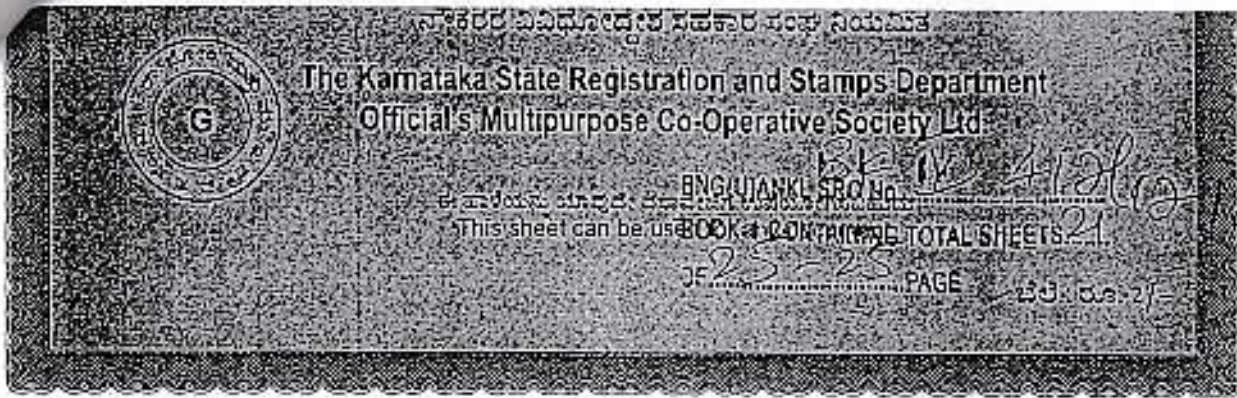
